OVERVIEW

Montauk Yacht Club Resort & Marina - a full-service resort and spa - is well known as a Long Island family vacation destination and New York City weekend getaway. Host to many Hamptons' weddings, events and meetings, guests come for the relaxation of pristine ocean beaches, the exciting lifestyle of The Hamptons, and Montauk's world-class saltwater fishing. For those desiring a more active holiday, Montauk is an internationally-recognized surfing destination and home to the award-winning Montauk Downs golf course. Surfing lessons and golf tee times can be arranged through the marina office or the hotel concierge. In addition to newly renovated guest rooms and public spaces, Montauk Yacht Club Resort & Marina offers visiting yachtsmen the benefits of all of its dining and recreational facilities. This includes three restaurants and bars, two outdoor swimming pools and one indoor swimming pool, a private beach, gym facilities (including saunas), Har-Tru tennis courts and a full-service spa. The Resort also offers a complementary shuttle to downtown Montauk, which provides shopping, dining and an internationally recognized beach. MYC accommodates yachts up to 232 feet, with a maximum draft of 12 feet.

ARRIVING

Montauk Yacht Club is open from April through December of each year and is easily accessible from the Long Island Sound as well as the Atlantic Ocean. For those arriving by land, the Resort is easily accessible by car, rail (via the Long Island Railroad), motor coach (regularly scheduled service from Manhattan on the Hampton Jitney), boat or plane from JFK, La Guardia or Islip Airport.

ABOUT MONTAUK

Montauk covers a total area of 19.8 square miles (51.2 km²) and has a full-time population of 3,851, which grows during the summer season. It also provides easy access to the storied Hamptons - the playground of New York's elite - with fine dining, shopping and recreational activities. During the summer season, the weather is usually beautiful and sunny, with daytime temperatures in the range of 78-85 degrees Fahrenheit (25 to 30 degrees Celsius). Spring and autumn are cooler and breezier, providing spectacular sailing conditions.

The main language spoken in Montauk is English. The currency in Montauk, NY is the United States dollar.

ACTIVITIES

Montauk is considered a beach town, and while it is most well known as a fishing and surfing destination, there are plenty of other activities to enjoy. Montauk also features an exciting nightlife from local Irish pubs to trendy Manhattan-style lounges. 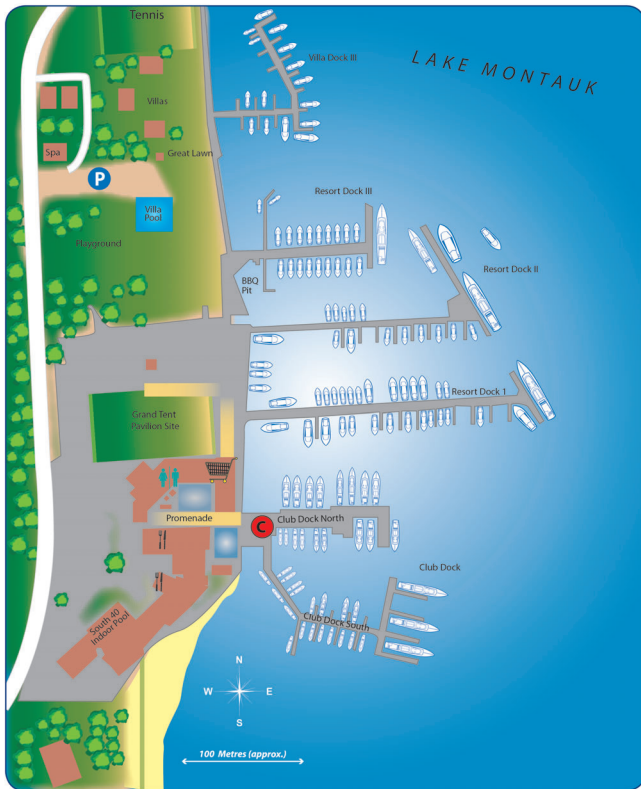
