## ARRIVING

The Newport area of Jersey City, NJ is accessible by air via Newark Airport, 15 minutes away. It is also within an hour of JFK and LaGuardia. Path trains, light rail and the Holland Tunnel are all within a few minutes walking or by car. Foreign nationals who have not cleared in may clear at the local port of entry. We will assist you when you arrive.

## CRUISING GROUNDS

The Northeast has much to offer in the way of cruising - from touring the island of Manhattan in the Hudson River, to sailing the Atlantic waters of New England. After taking in the City skyline and historic Ellis Island, traveling north toward Connecticut will lead you to more quaint towns and fishing villages. Stop over at IGY's Boston Yacht Haven or the Montauk Yacht Club; cruise to Newport, Rhode Island; Nantucket; Cape Cod or Martha's Vineyard for miles of beaches, sandy dunes and fresh seafood. Travel even further north to Maine, whose irregular coastline is over 3,500 miles, offering remote coves and offshore islands with fishing villages and small towns. Popular bays include Penobscot Bay, Blue Hill and Frenchman Bay and Mount Desert.
