## **Yacht Haven Grande Marina Status: Open**

**The US Virgin Islands remains OPEN to yacht entry, subject to strict health declarations.**

These health declarations are:

1. Do any of your crew or guests onboard your vessel have any flu-like symptoms?
2. Have any of your crew or guests, to the best of your knowledge, been in contact with anyone with flu like symptoms in the past 14 days?
3. Have any of your crew or guests been in contact with anyone confirmed to have contracted COVID-19 in the past 14 days?
4. Have any crew member or guests visited any of the following countries in the past 14 days?

Iran, China (excluding Hong Kong and Macau), the European states within the Schengen Area (Austria, Belgium, Czech Republic, Denmark, Estonia, Finland, France, Germany, Greece, Hungary, Iceland, Italy, Latvia, Liechtenstein, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Malta, Netherlands, Norway, Poland, Portugal, Slovakia, Slovenia, Spain, Sweden, Switzerland), United Kingdom and Republic of Ireland, and the Federative Republic of Brazil.

5. Please detail the countries visited (even if in transit) for each member of passenger and crew

As per our Governor's recommendation, **as of June 1<sup>st</sup> the USVI moved to 'Open Doors' status, meaning the majority of businesses can now reopen with social distancing and other protective measures being in place (.e.g limited seating in restaurants).**

The majority of businesses are now open with social distancing and masks worn indoor requirements in place.

Hotels, Air B&B, Timeshares are now permitted to accept any new bookings for visitors & tourists as of June 1.

St. Thomas airport is open for inbound and outbound flights; inbound arrivals are subject to scanning.

Restaurants and bars are operating with a limited amount of seating - please see Restaurant Limitations below.

Retail outlets are open for business with a limited number of people entering the establishment.

Beaches are open.

**Restaurant Limitations:**

- Establishments cannot cater to parties larger than six (6) people. Larger groups can be split up among multiple tables that are properly spaced apart.
- Restaurants and bars can only operate at half of the Fire Marshall approved seating capacity, or host a maximum of 50 customers - whichever is less.
- Tables must be 6' apart and bar stools must be spaced out as much as possible.
