

MARINA STATUS: OPEN

- Marina is open and currently accommodating vessels
- COVID-19 Protocols are in place (Contact marina for details)
- Borders are open intra EU Schengen
- Vessels currently in seas or departing must contact the General Manager prior to their arrival
- Bunkering, provisioning, concierge, custom clearance, support & logistic, transfer services are operational
- Bars, Restaurants and Theaters are open
- Vendor access allowed
- Group and social activity is restricted, but allowed outside the marina
- Sport activities, such as windsurfing, kite surfing, paddling, swimming, and running are allowed on the beaches

Is the marina accepting incoming vessels?

Yes - Please contact the General Manager prior arrival.

Are vessels allowed to depart the marina?

Yes. Transit between ports is allowed, no more restrictions.

Is there a curfew in place?

No. The curfew had been lifted as well as the self-isolation as of Monday, May, 11th, 2020.

Are vessel repairs available?

Yes, with your agents or through local agents.

Is fueling available?

Yes. Fuel can be arranged by contacting the IGY Sète Marina office or through local agents.

Are ports currently open?

Yes, as well as the beaches and other nautical activities.
