

Málaga 5-Day Itinerary

Day 1

Start at the Picasso Museum admiring the works of the famous painter in the town where he was born and enjoy the café at the museum. Then explore the Calle Molina Lario, the beautiful cathedral in the town center. Wander over to the Plaza Poeta Alfonso Canales and watch the sunset in the rooftop pool and bar while enjoying some amazing cocktails.

Day 2

Begin your morning in the Mercado Central to a little shopping before the market gets too busy. After that wander over to the Soho neighborhood. This barrio offers beautiful murals and street art sprinkled with art galleries and gastropubs. You can also enjoy the CAC museum while you are there. Explore the many restaurants to try as many tapas as possible in the evening.

Day 3

One of the most interesting spots to visit includes the Alcazaba, the Roman Theatre and Gibralfaro Castle. This area may take you most of the day to explore with structures dating back thousands of years. Wander over to Café Central Málaga that has been serving coffee since 1910. Then a moment to reflect on your day at the Arabic Baths where you can enjoy a wonderful spa experience. This relaxing adventure will get you ready to explore and try a few more tapas.

Day 4

Discover the beaches of Málaga where you can snack on espetos and catch some rays. You can spend the day having drinks and enjoying the food of the bars and restaurants that line the beaches. After you have relaxed on the beach all day you can spend the evening and night in one of Málaga's great clubs or discos.

Day 5

Take a walk to the century old park, Parque de Málaga, to admire the sculptures fountains and landscape that line the pathways near the shore. Along the tour of the park are two art museums: Museo de Málaga and the Centre Pompidou Málaga. After, enjoy the port area featuring brand-new architecture, shopping, restaurants and views.
