MARINA STATUS: OPEN

- Marina is open to International traffic (for allowed Nations)
- Marina is accepting transient under national safety rules
- Office is open to the public
- Marina is currently taking bookings
- Staff are answering phones and emails daily
- International flags docking arrivals are allowed (for allowed Nations)
- Vendor access is allowed
- Fuel station is open
- Group and social activity is allowed under Government rules
- Dock staff is present
- Security patrols 24/7
- Masks are required indoors
- To enter into Italy you will need:
 - Passenger Locator Form
 - EU Digital COVID Certificate or COVID-19 digital green certificate (based on country of origin) which shows proof of vaccination (at least 14 days prior), negative swab test result (either molecular, if taken within 72 hours prior to entry into Italy, or antigen, if taken within 24 hours prior to entry into Italy)
 - Whoever is unable to present a green Covid-19 certification of vaccination will nevertheless be required to present a negative swab test, as stated above, undergo self-isolation for a period of 5 days, under medical supervision, and then a mandatory repeat the (molecular or antigen) swab test.
