Canyoning Tour

The Boruca are a people who will teach us the good use of natural resources reflected in their way of using the raw material provided by the environment, for the production of balsa wood and cedar masks, obtaining natural dyes for fabrics and others handicrafts. These activities help maintaining a sense of togetherness and authenticity of their ancestral culture.

At the end of the workshop, we continue the adventure with a visit to the spectacular Boruca River where you can relax, cool off and swim.

Optional you can rappel.

Upon returning from the river, you will taste a delicious lunch prepared by the people of the community with typical dishes of the area.






Tour to the Caverns




